

Dear Parents,

Baptism is the first step of initiation into the Catholic Church and is also the first step of initiation into the local Parish. It celebrates the entry of your child into the Epiphany of the Lord parish where they will be supported and nourished in their faith development as an active member of the church. Epiphany of the Lord Parish aims to be a community of hope, providing spiritual nourishment to all people.

Now that you have made a choice for your child to be baptized, we would like to ensure that you know what this choice involves. Once you have enrolled your child by completing and submitting the Registration forms, you then need to complete the following three steps:

- Baptismal Preparation Meeting This meeting aims to provide parents with information about the Sacrament of Baptism and about the practicalities of the baptism itself. These are offered every other month on a Sunday afternoon at 1 pm at the parish office. Upcoming dates include September 29, 2019, November 17, 2019, January 12, 2020, March 15, 2020, May 17, 2020, and July 26, 2020. Please call the parish office to register for a class.
- 2. Sponsor options:
 - a. Submit two Sponsor certificates for active, confirmed Catholics, male and female, in good standing, at least 16 years old who seek to be a sponsor.
 - b. Submit one Sponsor certificate for an active, confirmed Catholic, male or female, in good standing, at least 16 years old who seeks to be a sponsor.
 - c. Or submit one Sponsor certificate, and one Christian Witness certificate for a baptized, active Christian of another denomination, one male and one female.
- Schedule a date and time for baptism
 This date will be confirmed with you once the minister has been scheduled.

The forms can be returned to: the parish office at St. Thomas Aquinas campus; by mail, to Shellee Murcko, Epiphany of the Lord Parish, 729 White St. Toledo, OH 43605; or in an envelope placed in the collection plate at any of our weekend Masses.
